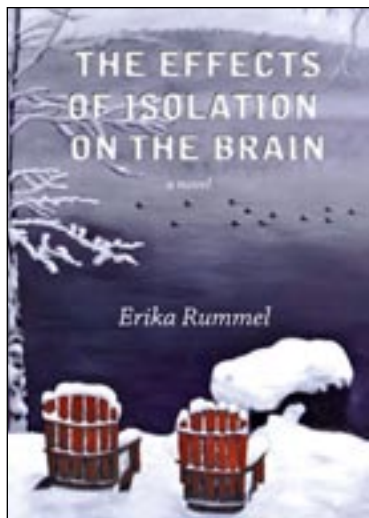

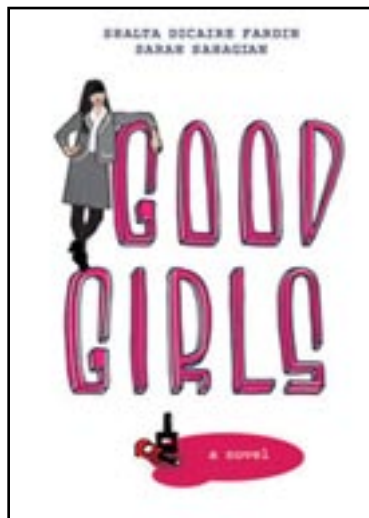


Erika Rummel: *The Effects of Isolation on the Brain*

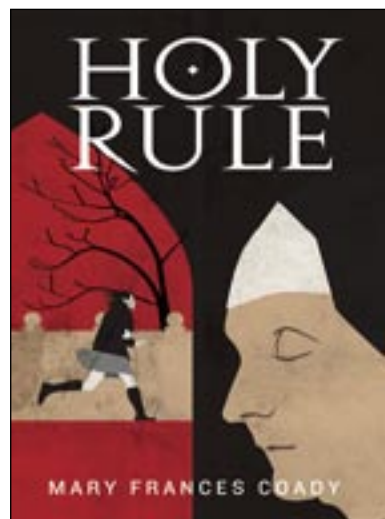
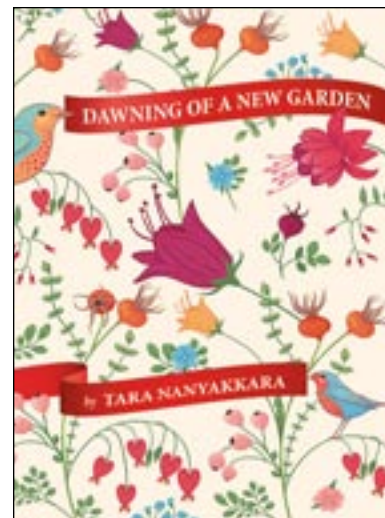


Shalta Dicaire Fardin & Sarah Sahagian: *Good Girls*
